

% of U.S. adults who get news from social media sites ...














Increased Social Media Citations in PubMed, 2007-2012

Urge Congress to Extend Critical Medicare Programs

Ask Congress to extend the Medicare Dependent Hospital (MDH) and Low-Volume Hospital (LVH) designations, the Conrad 30 J-1 Visa waiver program, and increased payments for rural ground ambulance services. As rural hospitals and providers begin to rebound from the COVID-19 pandemic, lifeline programs cannot lapse.

Urge Congress to Extend Relief from Medicare and PAYGO Sequestration

Urge Congress to Extend Relief from Medicare and PAYGO Sequestration

Urge Congress to extend relief from Medicare sequestration until the end of the Public Health Emergency and permanently waive the four percent PAYGO sequester triggered by passage of the American Rescue Plan Act. Sequestration deducts 2% from Medicare reimbursements to hospitals, estimated to result in \$228.5 million in losses for rural hospitals. On top of sequestration, PAYGO cuts will begin on January 1, 2023, further reducing payments to rural providers. Contact your elected officials to urge them to continue sequestration and PAYGO relief.






The FDA panel will meet 10/26 to hopefully authorize by early November. (which means children could be fully vaccinated by Christmas!)

While children are at a lower risk for severe disease or death from COVID-19 than adults, long-term complications are possible (like MIS-C) and risk reduction is important especially in crowded schools.
