University COVID-19 Response



Since 2010, the Raabe College of Pharmacy has directed ONU Healthwise, a multidisciplinary clinical practice of Ohio Northern University. The services under the umbrella of ONU HealthWise include a campus wide employee/student health and wellness clinic, rural mobile clinic, a community pharmacy, and drug and health information services, a telephonic pharmacy services center and student service learning/community outreach.

In the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, ONU HealthWise adapted its operations to meet the safety and healthcare needs of the campus and surrounding communities. In collaboration with the Student Health Center, Department of Athletic Training and University administration, a safety plan was developed that incorporated rapid antigen COVID-19 testing for campus surveillance (3%), symptomatic individuals, contact tracing and vaccination. As a result of this interdisciplinary effort, the University was able to maintain in-person instruction for the entirety of the 2020-21 academic year.

On-Campus COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Testing

Point-of-care rapid antigen testing was provided oncampus to all university employees, students and first responders based on the following protocol:

- All symptomatic individuals
- 3% random campus surveillance weekly
- NCAA athletic surveillance
 - High contact sport: 100% three times/week
 - Medium contact sport: 25% weekly
 - Low contact sport: 3% campus surveillance
