The scholarship funds are intended to promote professional development and training of individuals who contribute to the mission and vision of ORHA. ORHA members may apply for up to \$500. Members may apply to funds every two years; preference is given to members who have not previously received funds. These funds are provided in partnership with the State Office of Rural Health at the Ohio Department of Health.

On behalf of the Ohio Rural Health Association Board and membership, the Legislative Committee is submitting a letter of support to the House and Senate for the Healthcare Workforce Resilience Act (H.R. 6788). The bill would alleviate visa-based restrictions for international nurses and physicians who have trained in the United States, allowing these heroes to join the fight against the COVID-19 virus and diminish workforce shortages in rural America.


